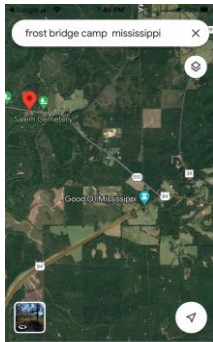




Frost Bridge rapids and swimming area

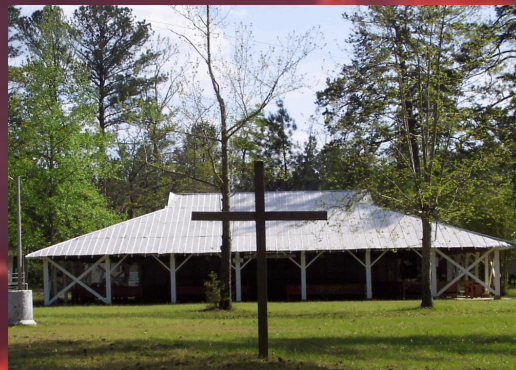

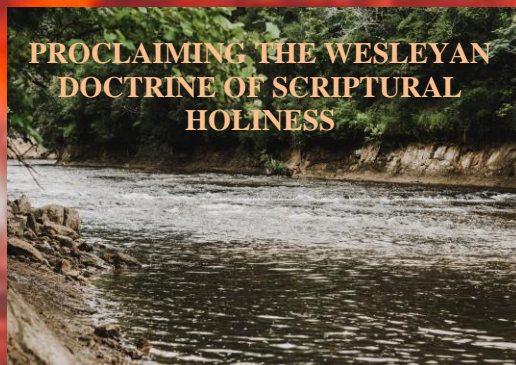

YOUTH ~ single bed sheets, money for snacks, and money for pizza (pizza night).

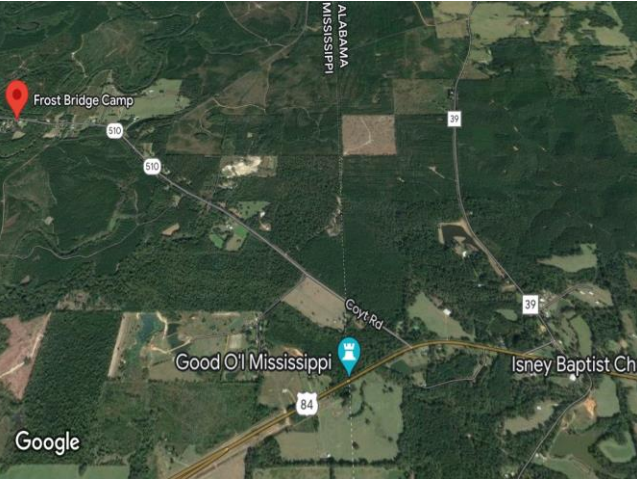
